## Our Amazing Deacons (Part II)

### The Role of the Deacon

*The almost total disappearance of the permanent diaconate from the Church in the West for more than a millennium has certainly made it more difficult to understand the profound reality of this ministry.*

*-Congregation for Catholic Education, Basic Norms for The Formation of Permanent Deacons, 1998*

The Second Vatican Ecumenical Council (1962-1965) has given new significance to the order of deacon. For more than fifty years, the diaconate in the Western Church is no longer seen as just a transitional stage to the priesthood, but is now valued as an important part of the public ministry of the Church. Since a deacon is ordained by a bishop, he participates in the apostolic ministry. Diaconate is a permanent commitment to the Church, and as in the Early Church, the deacon shares a unique relationship with the local bishop through the sacramental bond of Holy Orders.

The hallmark of the diaconate (both permanent and transitional to the priesthood) is *Word, Sacrament, and Charity*. As we know from our extensive benefits of the ministry of deacons in our parish, the deacon reads the Gospel and preaches and instructs the Faithful (*Word*) assists as an ordained minister at the altar and at baptisms and marriages (*Sacrament*), and ministers to the sick, the homebound, and the poor (*Charity*). On any given day outside of the liturgy, Deacons Gohl, Hayes, Lindley, O'Sullivan, Dalmer, and Briskey can be found teaching the Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults, providing baptismal instruction, leading the men's discussion groups, ministering to our two nursing homes, visiting the homebound and those in hospitals, prison ministry at Greenhaven Correctional Facility, exposing and reposing the Blessed Sacrament – the list goes on and on. Our deacons labor tirelessly in the vineyard, and for this our parish is so grateful.

So, as we conclude our two-part series, "Our Amazing Deacons," please include Deacons Gohl, Hayes, Lindley, O'Sullivan, Dalmer, and Briskey in your daily prayers. And if we have the opportunity to visit with them this weekend, give them a big thank you for their response to a truly unique and valuable service to the Church.
