## Lent 2018

This coming Wednesday, February 14 begins the Holy Season of Lent. Some people approach Lent with fear and trepidation, but in actuality, it is a remarkable time for us to re-assess our spiritual life, and deepen our relationship with Christ through prayer, fasting, almsgiving, and personal mortification. Beginning with the solemn distribution of ashes this coming Wednesday, additional Lenten programs at Regina Coeli will include:

- Stations of the Cross, Fridays at 7:00 p.m.
- Confessions every Monday during Lent from 7:30 p.m. until 8:30 p.m. (to compliment our regular Saturday afternoon confessions from 3:45 to 4:45 p.m. and the fact that we are always available for the Sacrament of Penance...walk-ins welcome!!!)
- Evening Mass every Wednesday at 7:00 p.m., offered by visiting priests from the Dutchess County Deanery.
- Reconciliation Monday – Confessions offered here and at every parish throughout the Archdiocese of New York and the Dioceses of Rockville Centre and Brooklyn, 3:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m.

So, there is much to look forward to!

The Holy Season of Lent requires the faithful to approach the practices of fast and abstinence with a spirit of prayer and penance. Fast and abstinence allows us to look beyond this world, to our ultimate citizenship, which is Heaven (Saint Paul's Letter to the Philippians, 3:20-21).

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstinence. All Fridays in Lent are days of abstinence. What does this exactly mean? Fasting and abstinence (Ash Wednesday and Good Friday) means that only one full meal can be taken on such days. Two other smaller meals may be taken during the day, but these two meals together should not equal one full meal. Eating between meals on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday is not permitted. Fasting is an obligation for Catholics ages fourteen to fifty-nine. Abstinence, which pertains to the consumption of meat is a requirement for all Catholics age fourteen and continuing throughout life. Days of abstinence are Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all the Fridays of Lent. Eating of meat is not permitted on these days during Lent. Blessings to all our parishioners as we begin our Lenten journey together. With the culmination of Lent being the Easter Triduum of Holy Thursday of the Lord's Supper, the Friday of the Passion of the Lord, and the Easter Vigil of the Holy Night, such joy awaits us!

## REVIEW OF ADORATION CHAPEL GUIDELINES IN THE EVENT OF INCLEMENT WEATHER

In the event of inclement weather, please tune into 92.1 FM for school closing listings, or on the web, search "Hyde Park Central School District," [hpcsd.org](http://hpcsd.org). If the district deems it necessary for a *school closing* or a *delayed opening*, the Adoration Chapel will be closed and reopen the following day after the 9:00 a.m. Mass.

Just a friendly reminder too, that the exposed Blessed Sacrament is never to be left unattended. On March 25, 2004, the Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments in Rome issued the Instruction, *Redemptionis Sacramentum: On Certain Matters to be Observed and Avoided Regarding the Holy Eucharist*. In this instruction, Exposition of the Holy Eucharist, and the care and protection of the Eucharist is specifically addressed:

[#138] Still, the Most Blessed Sacrament, when exposed, *must never be left unattended even for the briefest space of time*. It should therefore be arranged that at least some of the faithful always be present at fixed times, even if they take alternating turns.
